



C11 Portable Fire Extinguisher Recharging and Maintenance

The Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005

Article 17

Where necessary in order to safeguard the safety of relevant persons the responsible person must ensure that the premises and any facilities, equipment and devices provided in respect of the premises under this Order or, subject to paragraph (2), under any other enactment, including any enactment repealed by this Order, are subject to a suitable system of maintenance and are maintained in an efficient state, in efficient working order and in good repair.

Overview

It is estimated that throughout the UK there are several million portable fire extinguishers; each needs to be serviced regularly if it is to remain effective in case of a fire.
